

TIPS FOR STAYING AT GOODRICH CREEK

The cabins at Goodrich Creek are very comfortable. Each cabin features indoor plumbing, propane and electric lighting, and propane heaters. Both cabins are equipped with a stove, oven, refrigerator, hot water and an outdoor gas grill for your convenience. The kitchens have been stocked with the essentials from pots and pans to coffee cups, plates and silverware. There is a percolator for coffee. The bathrooms have a shower, but please bring your own towel and soap. In the bedrooms, there are foam mattresses, but you need either a sleeping bag and pillow, or something comparable. The water in the cabins is fresh creek water, but not for drinking. Drinking water is provided, but you might want to bring some bottled water to have while you are fishing.

The ranch roads are dirt and gravel, and are best suited for pickups, SUVs, vans and larger passenger cars, although early and late season customers will be informed as to vehicle limitations that may occur due to weather conditions. Compact car owners may use the roads with caution and at their own risk.

The town of Westwood is only a short drive away, where there are stores, gas stations and a couple of restaurants.

**Remember, Check-in time is 3 p.m. on your arrival date.
CABIN check-out time is 11 a.m. on your departure date
but you are invited to fish until 3 p.m.**
